Dear friends of Hope 4 Athletes,

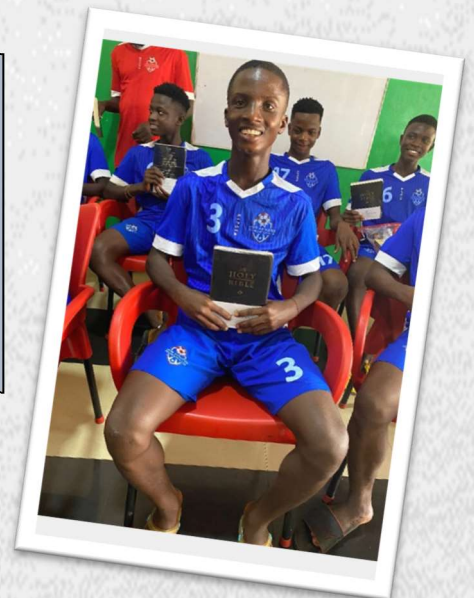
As we enter the new year, we are so thankful for your continual prayers and support. God has been so good this past year, and we are trusting in him in the new year.

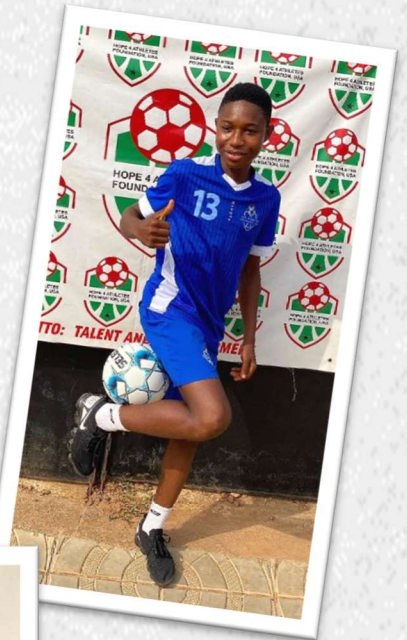
