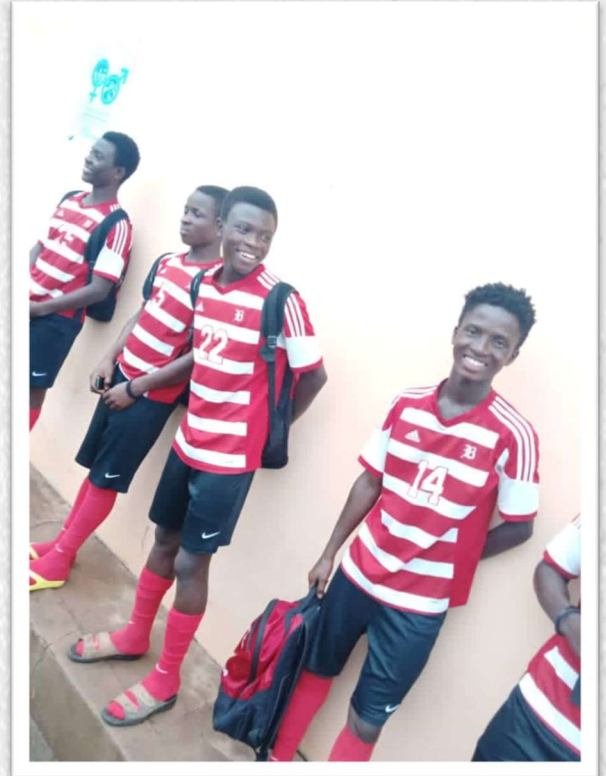
Dear friends of Hope 4 Athletes,
